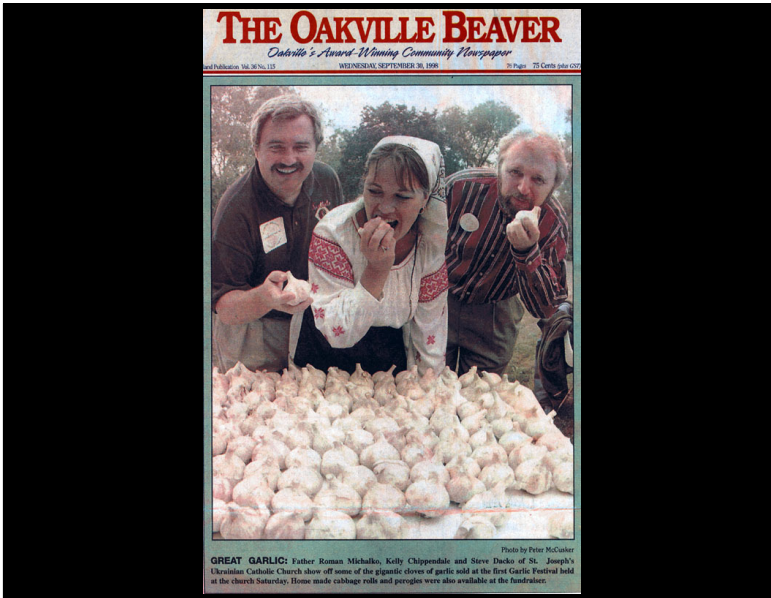

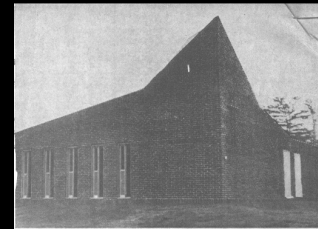

OAKVILLE — A new church building of uniquely modern design is nearing completion on the east side of the Ninth Line, a short distance north of St. Anthony's Anglican Church. It is a low structure of dark red brick, rising in a peak at the southeast corner. The brick is of the Dutch type, which has a recessed, mottled look, and the windows are long and narrow.

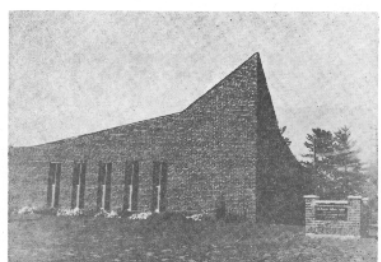
This is St. Joseph's Ukrainian Church of the Byzantine Rite, which will be ready for the end of June. The official opening will be some time later. The main construction, much of which is being done by members of the congregation, has been in progress since last August.

UNIVERSAL BUILDING
The congregation had to occupy this unusual building in order to carry out its activities. The parish was started in 1958 as a mission of the Roman Catholic Parish of St. Andrew's in Markham, and the first mass was celebrated in St. Andrew's Roman Catholic Church by Rev. Gregory Ryshakovich. Religious services were held in the basement of St. Mary's school for the last five years of the building's construction.
